This year Art Trek will offer art scholarships of up to \$1,500 to local high school seniors who plan to attend a Ventura County Community College.

SCHOLARSHIPS

- 1. The **Allison Renee Young Arts Scholarship** is awarded to a high school senior with special needs/a disability who wishes to attend a Ventura County Community College and meets the criteria of the scholarship.
- 2. The First-Generation Higher Education Arts Scholarship is awarded to a high school senior who is first generation in his/her family to attend a Ventura County Community College and meets the criteria of the scholarship. (A sibling who is currently enrolled or recently attended college does not disqualify you from applying for this scholarship.)

These awards are determined on a basis of need and potential for future success. Therefore, submission requires an art portfolio/video, essay, two (2) letters of recommendation and a copy of your high school transcript. All students who meet the criteria are encouraged to apply.



PORTFOLIOS

Visual & Literary Arts portfolio shall include:

3-5 pieces of artwork for visual or literary arts

All visual materials should be labeled with artist's name, title of each piece, and year or date completed. Visual arts pieces shall also include media and dimensions.

Portfolio artwork may include drawings, paintings, photographs, ceramics, digital works, mixed media, printmaking, sculptures, or literary work.

Performing Arts portfolio shall include:

1-2 audition or performance videos for those students pursuing studies in music or acting.

All audition and performance videos must include your name, title of piece being performed, location and date of video.

Portfolios and videos should include work that has been completed within the past two years.

ESSAY

This essay is an opportunity to express your interest in pursuing an education in the arts. Please pick one essay below.

Your statement should be 350-550 words in length.



LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

Two letters of recommendation are required.

- 1. The first letter shall be from a current or past school representative such as a teacher, administrator, or school counselor.
- 2. The second letter shall be from a non-related adult who is familiar with your character and strengths such as a mentor, community member, case manager, religious leader, or tutor. *

 (*Please do not ask a family member for this recommendation)

TRANSCRIPT

A copy of your high school transcript shall be submitted with the application.

DEADLINE by midnight on May 3, 2020 to arttrek.org/scholarships

OR

Please mail in your application to Art Trek at 703 Rancho Conejo Blvd. Newbury Park, CA. Postmarked by May 2nd, 2020.

Submit your completed application along with your portfolio, essay and high school transcript by **May 3, 2020**.

If you are a chosen as a finalist, a 20-30 minute in-person interview will be conducted between **May 20th through 22nd** at Art Trek.

All finalists will be notified via email of their standing regarding the scholarships by **5pm on May 22, 2020.**

PRESENTATIONS

Scholarships will be awarded MAY 29, 2020 at 4:30p.m. at Art Trek.

Please be available on this date and time if you are chosen as a recipient.
